Responsibilities:

The BIM Manager is responsible for the coordination and implementation of training and education of team members related to the BIM/Revit process and procedures, including other related software. They administer the BKV Design Documentation Standards and day to day Revit activities based on policies as directed by the Director of Operations and in support of BKV Leadership. Oversees the BIM Specialist Team in support project team needs with software issues and troubleshooting, content/family creation, standards development and maintenance, as well as oversight of project team's Revit model health, continuously looking for opportunities to improve productivity and efficiency of the project teams. In addition to these broad stroke management tasks, the BIM Manager shall perform the following duties:

- Develop BKV BIM capabilities to meet and exceed the demands of the industry, while formulating long-range goals
 and objectives to keep BKV at the forefront of software and technology, with support of the Director of Operations
 and IT Manager. Evaluate the utilization and implementation of BIM and other software needs used by the various
 disciplines for recommendation and approval by BKV Leadership.
- Establish and implement strategies and goals with the Director of Operations and BKV Design Documentation
 Standards Group to assist in meeting the goals and objectives of BKV Group for improved efficiency and production.
 Work with the discipline user group to review issues and establish a basis for implementing BKV established goals
 and objectives across all practice sites and disciplines.
- Develop, implement and train on standardized BIM/Revit project related process and procedures for delivery of documents at various phases.
- Assist in the production of BKV design documentation phases with BIM Execution Plans, modeling of Revit
 families/content, creation and maintenance of standard units and details, automating routines to support BKV
 standards with increased efficiency and productivity in utilizing the software.
- Provide periodic health checks of project models to understand the project team's knowledge of BKV Design
 Documentation Standards as well as skills with the software. Notify the Project Manager/Discipline Leads with areas
 for improvement within the project documents. Develop team member specific training and group training agendas
 on common themes uncovered via model health checks for areas of improvement in team member's skills.
- Manages the BIM Specialist Team at each practice site. Oversees the BIM Specialist Team support to all project
 team members, with a customer service focus, to address in a timely manner all Revit and other applicable software
 troubleshooting issues, requests for support, and administration of BIM process and procedures. Assist the IT
 Manager with troubleshooting on software, hardware and network issues as required related to BIM production.
- Acts as a liaison with all outside vendors for required software and technology, with the IT Manager and Director of Operations. Administers software licensing, software setup and installation including programming, new hire training, etc.

- Oversees and/or conducts required clash detection of project models utilizing Navisworks or other similar software. Notifies project team of clash reports for resolution on projects.
- Conduct periodic evaluation of potential new hire Revit skills as needed.
- Coordinates with the Director of Finance on equipment and software needs for budgeting purposes, in coordination
 with the IT Manager and Director of Operations. Develops annual software budget estimates for review with
 Director of Finance, and provides a purchase order for review and approval prior to purchase of requested
 hardware/software.
- Maintains a free flow of communications with the Director of Operations relative to duties and activities.
- Ensure implementation of BKV Design Documentation Standards and procedures during the project delivery process, expressing positive team leadership and mentoring.
